## Rules and Regulations for Owen Farm Summer Camp 2020

1. Arrival time for each camp will be 7:30-8:00am and pickup time will be promptly at 4:00-4:14 pm. Please provide a list of people that your child may ride with. If your child going to be late please call ahead so that we can start the activities and reassign the animals.
2. Please understand that Owen Farm is a working farm and represents certain risks to your child. Please stress the importance of cooperation and listening skills to your child. Farm camp is designed to provide leadership skills, team work, listening skills, respect for other and how to have fun in the sun. They will learn and understand about farm life, planting and harvesting and the concept "from the farm to the table."
3. Lunch will be provided for your child each day unless your child has allergies or needs special foods. If this is the case, then the child must bring their own lunch and snacks. As for a picky child. We serve sandwiches, hotdogs, Mac & Cheese, chicken nuggets, and other kid friendly items. The menu changes daily. We also provides chips, cookies and farm products.
4. Your child will be responsible for providing a morning snack, a Gatorade or bottled water daily. We provide water, lemon aid and Kool-Aid in 5 gallon containers and your child will have their own cup and they will have access to all of it thorough out the day, the bottled one will be for farm activities when we are on the wagon. Absolutely NO CANDY, GUM OR SOFT DRINKS are permitted at anytime.
5. Each child is encouraged to bring a disposable cameras on Monday and we will return them on Friday. NO CELLPHONES are allowed at anytime unless they are being used as cameras but must stay in our possession at all times. NO Exceptions
6. Your child can bring buckets or water toys for the creek
7. Open toed shoes are allowed during most activities but please make sure your child packs closed toed shoes for horseback riding and field work.
8. We will enjoy the creek each day so please provide your child a bathing suit or change of clothes, a beach or bath towel, water shoes or crocs, sunscreen and bug spray. Label each so that if they get left out of their knapsacks we will know where they belong.
9. Fishing rods and nets are permitted, please put your child's name on each and they are fully responsible for keeping up with them. Left attended could mean a ride down the creek into the river.
10. A hat or bandanna can be worn during hot sun time activities and is recommended.
11. Handling farm animals are part of their daily routine and may cause minimal scratching and we will treat with Neosporin and band aids. Bee stings and splinters are also part of outdoor farm life. We will avoid all incidents if at all possible but will handle any minor abrasions as quickly as possible.
12. Bad language, violent behavior, name calling, hitting or spitting will not be tolerated in any form and at any time. Please inform your child this will result in a period of time out and a phone call to you.
